Walk in our Shoes: Understanding the Latino Experience

The *Walk In Our Shoes* Latino simulation experience is designed to help participants begin to understand what it might be like to live as a typical Latino in our community. It is a simulation, not a game. The object is to sensitize participants to the realities faced by area Latinos.

Participants are given a profile with some background information. They then experience four 12-minute days trying to accomplish ordinary tasks in the life of that Latino.

This simulation was developed through the support and efforts of ThedaCare's Community Health Action Team (CHAT), ESTHER, and dedicated individuals in our community.



Schedule a Latino Simulation for your organization and spread the word!

- Up to 52 participants assume the roles of up to 26 Latino individuals
- The experience lasts about two and one-half hours, including a short video and discussions to process the experience.
- Outside the Fox Valley, the Simulation costs \$500 for nonprofits.
